

## OPTION 1

**Public footpath.** Approximately 1m in width fenced on both sides. Any hedging, fencing height, style, materials etc. will be managed at the appropriate time.

## OPTION 2

**Permissive path.** Single line fencing with no barbed wire. Minimum width 2m. Over the coming years any new hedging or fencing on the southern side to a permissive path will be maintained to a maximum height of 4ft.

The above path is **now open** once again with immediate effect. We do however ask that dogs are kept on a lead for the time being and people do not wander onto the crops. Formal signage will be erected in due course but please note no cycling or horses.

The fencing will be completed in two phases. One half of the route will be temporarily closed while works are carried out, with the other half remaining open. Once the first section is complete, the arrangement will be reversed so that access is maintained throughout. The fencing represents a significant investment by the estate, and the group should be aware that we would not be undertaking this work unless it were intended as a long-term solution.

Please note: The path will be closed for one day whilst the gas repair team attend to the damage (H&S requirement). Once we have confirmation of their schedule we will advise you of that date. There are no other planned closures for the remainder of the year. They will also be placing marker flags and red paint to identify the underground

pipes so that fencing posts can be correctly positioned. It would be helpful if these flags are not moved or walked over, please also avoid walking over the red spray paint.
